#### The cavea

In the Greek theater, the Cavea is the palce for spectators, distributed around the Orchestra, where the choir is located. Here, the theme of the auditorium is mirrored, the entire project site becomes a place of representation where the actor plays a fundamental active role. The complexity of the natural materials defines the setting of the scenes and dominates the figure of Demeter, protector of the Earth.



### The ground

The coexistence of different elements of the landscape composes the scene of the project. The soil is the central element, it is varied and discontinuous and consists of several and different materials such as vegetation,



# The journey

The path is a "journey from A to B", that allows the imaginary of the cinema and the theater to guide the visitor toward a dreamlike world, where he himself is the actor. A common thread connects the myth of Nature to the figurative power of cinema and theater and allows the viewers to deeply merge with it.





The materials represent the elements that are necessary for the understanding and the construction of the project. They allow to create a close relationship with the site through the stimulation of the five senses and at the same time, they allow to enjoy the environment through artificial tools, bonded to the dreamlike imaginary.
