


The Site- A Natural Paradise

Fig. 1 Concept analysis




Welcome to [The Cinema Closest to Paradise]

Fig. 2 Design strategy display




CHAPTER 02

How[The Cinema Closest to Paradise] Works?


We use local stone materials to conform to the original terrain and regularize the ground, so that people can sit on the ground and watch movies projected on the cliff. The pool on the original site is preserved, and people can play here. We have designed a special device for lodge to float in the air. When the airbag is opened, the cabin rises from the ground and has a wonderful experience in the background of the sky. The opening degree of the airbag can control the height of the cabin. We designed the cave as a place where conference and drama rehearsals can be held, theater lovers can get a deep experience here.

Fig.4 Weather Analysis




The climate is mild, the coldest is over 0°C, and the hottest month is about 30°C. Winter is rainy and summer is dry. The wind is often from northeaster.




Fig.11 People go to the movies together




Fig. 14 People watch movies in caves
