

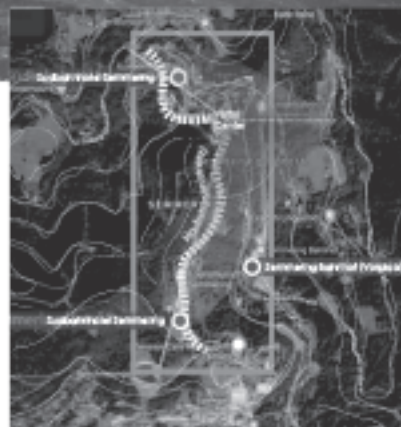
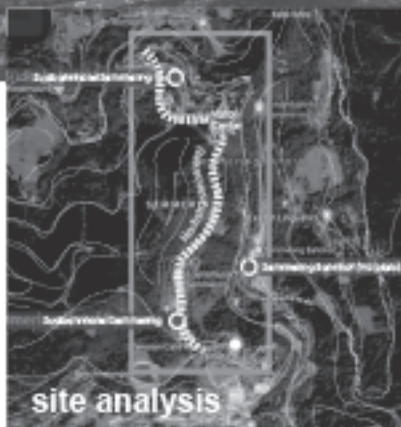
FOLDED FOREST

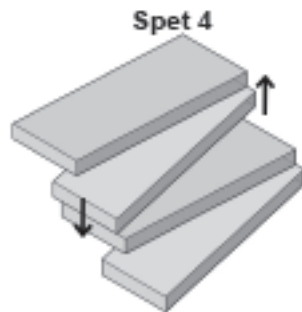

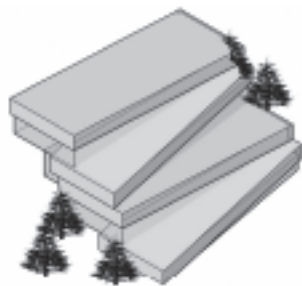

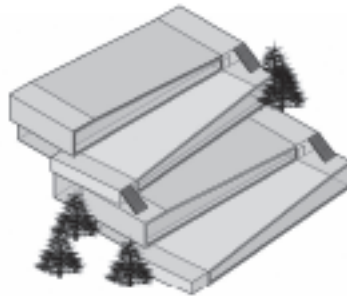

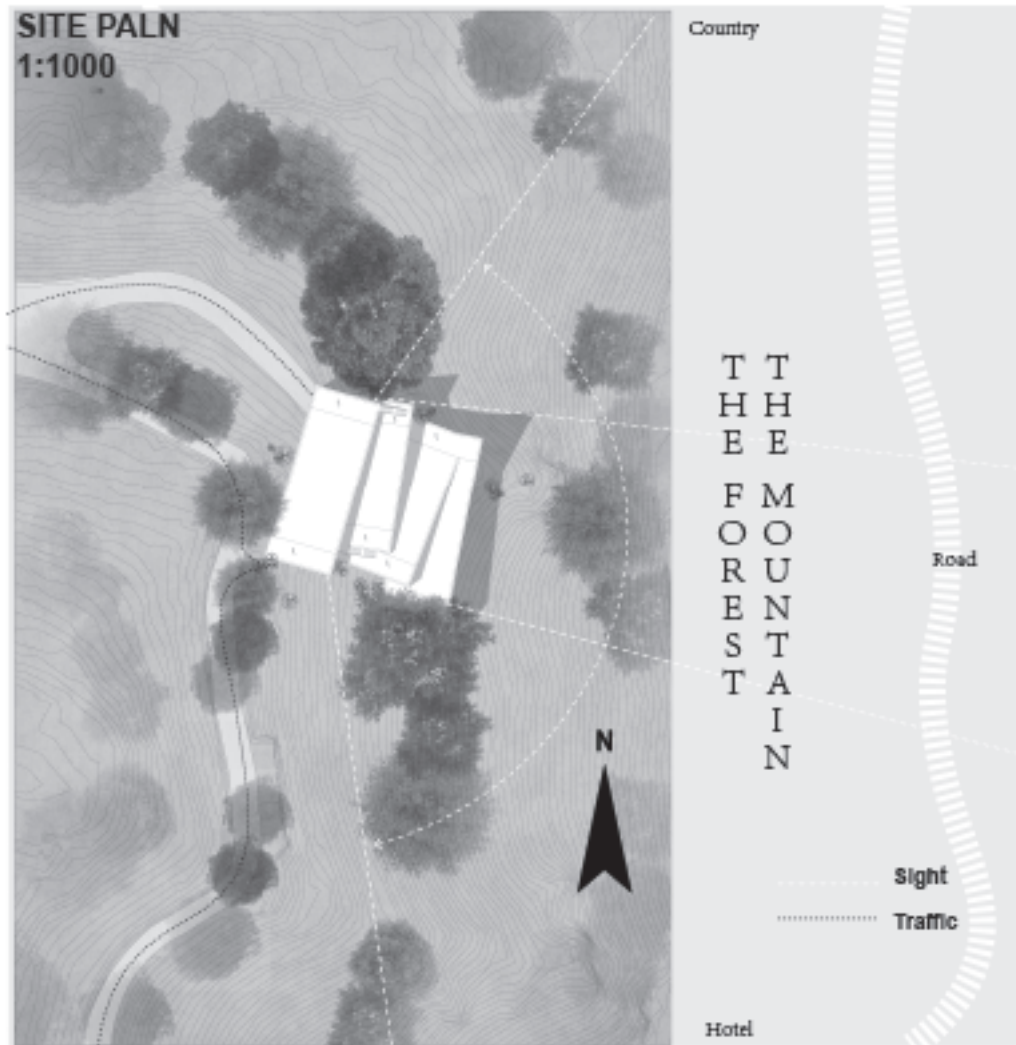

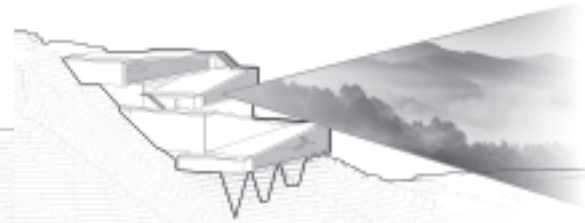

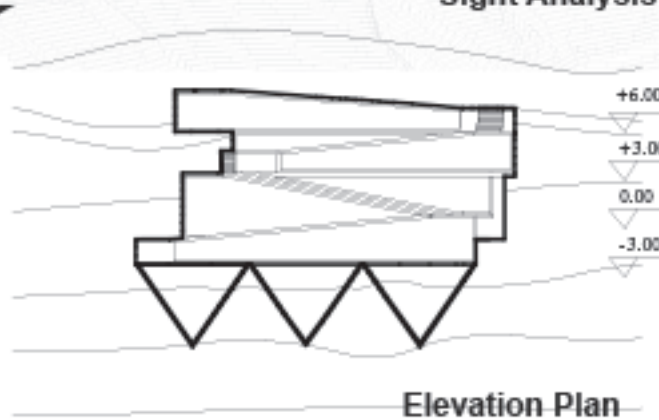
